PPD/NGC PROJECTS

Keeyask G.S.

Delay all expenditures as much as possible while protecting the December 2019 ISD and maintaining separation between the Infrastructure and Generation projects.

Conawana

Delay all expenditures as much as possible while protecting the Fall 2025 ISD.

Pointe du Bois Spillway Replacement

Defer ISD to 2016.

Keewatinoow and Riel Converter Stations

Delay all expenditures as much as possible while maintaining the 2017 ISD. Look at staging with Conawapa 2025. Look at options if TL ISD delayed by 1 year.

PSO PROJECTS

Ontario Firm Import Upgrade Defer by 5 years to 2018.

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HVde PROJECTS

Defer or delay as per email from John McNichol to me September 20, 2011.

Dorsey Relay Building

Look at possibility of deferring upgrade.

Syuc upgrades

Look at possibility of deferring balance or waiting for problems to occur.

ESD PROJECTS

Kelsey G.S.

Defer installation of Unit #7 for 2 years.

Great Falls

Delay awarding all further contracts for 3 to 4 years. Receive ordered equipment and mothball.

Pine Falls

Delay awarding all further contracts for 3 to 4 years. Receive ordered equipment and mothball.

Pointe du Bois Powerhouse Rehab

Delay awarding all further contracts for 3 to 4 years. Receive ordered equipment and install where part of the supply contract. Minimize powerhouse safety expenditures to the absolute minimum.
